

CYCU Regulations Governing the Establishment of the Curriculum Committee of the School of Design

Passed by the 2nd College Curriculum Committee of Spring Semester, 2007 Academic Year, on
March 19, 2007

Amended per the letter Yuan-Mi-Zi No. 0990000878 dated March 30, 2010

Passed by the 1st College Curriculum Committee of Spring Semester, 2011 Academic Year, on
March 1, 2012

Article 1 The Curriculum Committee of the School of Design, hereinafter referred to as the Committee, has been established in accordance with the provisions of Article 14 of the Chung Yuan Christian University Organizational Charter.

Article 2 The Committee is composed of the Dean, heads of each department, and one faculty representative and two student representatives from each department.

Faculty representatives must be associate professors or senior assistant professors with at least three years of service.

Student representatives are jointly elected by the student associations of each department.

The Dean shall serve as the chairperson during the meeting.

Article 3 The Committee may hire a number of university and external experts and alumni representatives to serve as consultants of the Committee for curriculum development improvements.

Article 4 The Committee shall be responsible for the following tasks:

- I. Review the required courses for each department and degree program.
- II. Review the relevant cross-departmental programs and general education courses of the School.
- III. Review the principles governing course offerings for all courses within the School.
- IV. Review other course-related matters.

Article 4-1 Each course offering unit in the School shall conduct an external review of the curriculum structure at least once every four years. The purpose is to comprehensively review the suitability and pertinence of its educational goals, student core competency indicators, and curriculum structure, as well as the alignment of teachers' expertise and teaching subjects.

Article 5 The Committee shall convene at least one meeting every semester. Cases reviewed and approved by the Committee shall be submitted to the University-Level Curriculum Committee for review.

Article 6 The Association may invite relevant personnel to attend the meetings if necessary.

Article 7 The Regulations have been announced and implemented upon approval from the College Affairs Meeting and submission to the Academic Affairs Meeting for review and filing. The same procedure shall apply to all subsequent amendments.
