Implementation of Access Control for CYCU Campus (18 May, 2021)

In response to the rapid evolution of pandemic, access control for CYCU campus will be implemented in several ways:

- I. From now on, except from the main entrance of CYCU and the other entrance next to the Holistic Village remain open, other entrances are blocked, in response to the following announcement and consensus,
 - (I) Official announcement made by the Ministry of Education on 14 May in which it says that universities and colleges in Taiwan shall put the following measures into action, "For the purpose of risk control, School shall assign personnel to measure visitor's/ staff's/ faculty's body temperature before accessing to the campus when the School is open", "Launching contact-information-based policy" and "Wearing face mask"
 - (II) Consensus which has been made in the CYCU Disease Prevention Meeting on 17 May, which is prohibiting visitor whose purpose of visiting is not for business from entering the campus, and requesting staffs to take turns to work from home.
- II. Starting from 20 May, every weekday, from 7:30 am to 5:30 pm, staffs will take shift to implement the policy of "Identity Management and Access Control" at the aforementioned entrances. For individual who is not here for business or with fever (forehead or axilla temp.≥37.5°C/ear temp.≥38°C) is prohibited to access to the campus.
- III. From now on, underground parking lot located in the Dickson Lee Hall is temporarily closed to visitors.
- IV. From now on, for those who would like to get on/off the bus at the bus stop located at the Holistic Village, please refer to the bus stop near the Chung Yuan Elementary School or Hsin-Shih Dorm instead.

We sincerely apologize for any inconvenience the aforementioned disease prevention measures may have caused you. With your effort and cooperation, we shall get through tough times and see the light at the end of the tunnel.
