Second Foreign Language Course Exemption Regulations for Undergraduate Students Department of Teaching Chinese as a Second Language, Chung Yuan Christian University

Established in the 2nd Regulations Group Meeting on 2018.4.25 (106-2-2) Revised and Approved in the 5th Department Meeting on 2018.5.9 (106-2-5)

- Article 1 In order to allow students with outstanding second foreign language proficiency to be exempt from the second foreign language course, these regulations are established.
- Article 2 Domestic students who meet one of the following conditions in the second foreign language proficiency test may apply for exemption from the second foreign language course:

- Article 3 Foreign students who pass the Advanced Level of the Test of Chinese as a Foreign Language (TOCFL) may apply for exemption from the second foreign language course by submitting the relevant certification.
- Article 4 Students who meet the qualifications must submit the relevant certification to the Department of Applied Chinese Literature office before the course drop deadline to apply for exemption. Students who do not submit the application will be considered to voluntarily remain in the original class and continue the second foreign language course.
- Article 5 Students who are exempted from the second foreign language course do not earn the 8 credits associated with the second foreign language course.
- Article 6 These regulations will be implemented after approval by the department meeting and will be announced for enforcement. Any revisions will follow the same process.
